Responsibilities and reporting of Consultant (Epidemiology)

1. The Consultant will work under the direct guidance of the NACO's SI-Surveillance & Epidemiology and in consultation with the Focal Person at ICMR-NIMS.
2. The HoD of Strategic Information division at State AIDS Control Society (JD/DD/AD as per the position sanctioned) will be focal person of coordination by the Epidemiologists in the allotted States.
3. The Consultant will support the implementation of Surveillance & Epidemiological activities as defined under the MoU between the NACO and the ICMR-NIMS. This shall include, but not limited to, undertaking, and supporting epidemiological investigations, verbal autopsy, supportive supervision, capacity building, periodic review etc. in the facility/community field settings.
4. He/she shall provide epidemiological support to the allocated State AIDS Control Societies (SACSS) towards evidence-driven response planning, implementation, and monitoring under the direct guidance of
