Brief on the Organization:

Indian Institute of Public Health Gandhinagar (IIPHG) is a University established under IIPHG Act, 2015 of Gujarat State. It offers courses in the field of Public Health. It also undertakes various research projects in the field of Public Health. The university is established by Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) with support from the Government of Gujarat, Department of Health & Family Welfare.

Project Brief

The project 'NIVARAN' aims to screen approx. 45000 population in the age group of 30-64 years residing in the randomly selected 25 tea estates of chosen 5 districts of Assam (namely, Jorhat, Golaghat, Sivasagar, Tinsukia & Dibrugarh) with the non-lab- based, non-invasive and validated screening tool for the risk assessment of cardiovascular diseases. The screened individuals will be risk stratified based on high, moderate, and low risk and provided interventional strategy accordingly.

Deliverables:

a) Project Implementation:

- Develop the micro plan for the field activities.
- Help in developing data collection tool for baseline study and screening activity in the field.
- Train the project team for program objectives.

b) Monitoring & Evaluation

- Periodic supervisory feedback to the project team.
- Monitor field activities and give technical support.
- Periodic supervisory visits to the project site
- Evaluation of the field findings.

c) Report writing & documentation

- Dissemination of the field reports to the funding agency
- Provide narrative & financial reports to the funding agency.
- Assist the investigators in scientific publications of the field findings.
